It belongs to the Community of the Herzegovinian Franciscans of the Province of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Mostar, BiH. It was founded in 1993, during the war in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The building and operating was started by Father Slavko Barbariæ and the project was aided by the Franciscan School Sisters of The Holy Family from the Herzegovinian Province. The Mother's Village evolved out of the need for protection and care for the children who were wounded by the loss of their homes and parental care during and after the war. It started working officially on September 8, 1996.

The Mother's Village was built and maintained by pilgrims and donors from all over the world.
